Ensembles, orchestras, bands and choirs:

- Provision of a range of groups at beginner, intermediate and advanced levels, at four Area Music Centres on a weekly basis
- Ad hoc workshops and Easter and summer courses.

Qualifications at the East Sussex Academy of Music in partnership with Sussex Downs College:

- A level Music
- A level Music Technology
- BTEC level 3 Music
- Pre-professional course

Singing:

- Singing opportunities, including Big Sings

Music Experiences:

- Access to large scale and high quality music experiences through our Music 360 programme that supports young people with potential and other ad hoc opportunities
- Grant-funded projects, for example bringing live music into schools

Services to schools:

- Whole class ensemble tuition
- Ready for School transition programme
- Let's Make Music (pre-instrumental music programme)
- After school clubs and bands / choirs, workshops, festivals

School support and Continuous Professional Development (CPD):

- Direct delivery and / or commissioning of CPD opportunities for school staff
- Support to review music provision in schools and advice and guidance about developing provision
- CPD opportunities for instrumental teachers and community musicians and provision of the Certificate of Music Education qualification

Instrumental hire:

- Hire of instruments to schools to support whole class ensemble tuition
- Possible continuation of instrumental hire direct to students for small group and individual lessons
