


Proposed A22 Active Travel Measures - Overview


We have developed a package of active travel (walking, wheeling and cycling) measures to support the A22 Major Road Network junction improvements in the Hailsham/Hellingly, Polegate and Stone Cross area.

Context

- The A22 is part of Government's Major Road Network
- The County Council previously consulted on proposals for five junction improvements between Boship Roundabout and Stone Cross in summer 2021
- Now we want your views on an additional package of complementary active travel (walking, wheeling, cycling) measures identified through the East Sussex Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP)
- The outcome of this consultation will be included in a Full Business Case to the Government's Department for Transport in 2025/26

Objectives

 Improve active travel access within and between local communities to jobs, education, shops etc

 Encourage and improve local journeys on foot, for people with mobility issues (wheeling) and by bike

 Improve safety for pedestrians, wheelers and cyclists

 Improve people's health and wellbeing

 Help reduce carbon emissions and improve air quality
