The East Sussex (A267 Mayfield and Five Ashes)

(50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 84(1) and (2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 mph on those lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The East Sussex (A267 Mayfield and Five Ashes) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 27th March 2009.

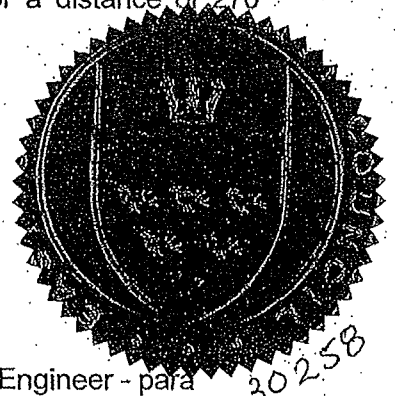
SCHEDULE
50 mph Speed Limit

- a) A267 Mayfield – from a point 290 metres north of its junction with Criers Lane to a point 70 metres west of its junction with Mayfield Roundabout.
- b) Roselands Avenue – from its junction with the A267 for the whole of its length (total 200 metres)
- c) Rothermead Road – from its junction with the A267 for the whole of its length (total 115 metres)
- d) Berkley Road – from its junction with the A267 for the whole of its length (total 85 metres)
- e) Meres Lane – from its junction with the A267 southwards for a distance of 270 metres
