## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## The East Sussex (C39 High Street, Alfriston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2025

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The East Sussex (Various Roads, Alfriston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1992 first schedule 'no waiting at any time' (b) (ii) and second schedule 'no waiting 8am 7pm on Monday through Sunday inclusive' (a) are hereby revoked.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles three and four of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait:-
  - (a) At any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in schedule one to this order.
- 3. Nothing in Article two of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) A person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) Goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely-
    - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads; or
    - (iv) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (e) The vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (f) The vehicle to be used for emergency services purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Article two shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays, in the relevant position, a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- 5. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (C39 High Street, Alfriston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on 21 July 2025.
