ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**The East Sussex (Avis Road, Newhaven)
(Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202***

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The length of road specified in Schedule One to this Order is to become a restricted road.
2. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule Two to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.
4. The following Order is revoked in part: "The East Sussex (Various Roads) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 1992", Second Schedule Item (b) - Avis Road, Newhaven - from a point approximately 37 metres northwest of the western kerbline of Avis Way, to its junction with A26 New Road.
5. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (Avis Road, Newhaven) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202*" and shall come into operation on DD MM YYYY.

**SCHEDULE ONE
Restricted Road**

**Avis Road,
Newhaven**

From a point approximately 23 metres northwest of its junction with Avis Way, northwestwards to a point approximately 50 metres north of New Road (cul-de-sac).

SCHEDULE TWO
40 mph Speed Limit

**Avis Road,
Newhaven**

From a point approximately 50 metres north of its junction with New Road (cul-de-sac), northwards to its junction with A26 New Road.
