ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (Various Roads)
(30 / 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1992

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 82(2), 83(2), 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. Those lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule to this Order shall have restricted road status (and accordingly no person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on those lengths of road).
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
3. The provision of Articles 1 and 2 shall not apply to any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for that purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.
3. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (Various Roads) (30 / 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1992" and shall come into operation on 13 July 1992.

FIRST SCHEDULE
30 mph Speed Limit

CATSFIELD

| (a) | Church Lane C345 | - | from its junction with the A269 south-eastwards to its junction with Church Road, a distance of approximately 260 metres. |
| (b) | Church Road C345 | - | from its junction with the A269 eastwards and south-eastwards to a point approximately 67 metres east of the eastern wall of Catsfield Church of England Primary School, a distance of approximately 550 metres. |

- (c) Skinners Lane UC7699 - from its junction with the A269 westwards to a point approximately 34 metres west of the western boundary of the property known as "Poplars", a distance of approximately 370 metres.

HAILSHAM

- (d) Station Road C411 - from a point approximately 10 metres southeast of the south-eastern boundary of No. 154 Station Road, north-westwards for approximately 155 metres.

WESTHAM

- (e) Hankham Hall Road C708 - from a point approximately 8 metres northwest of the northern boundary of the property known as "Belvedere", south-eastwards to its junction with Peelings Lane, a distance of approximately 295 metres.
- (f) Peelings Lane C1100 - from a point approximately 55 metres west of the boundary between "Meadowbank" and "Down Ash", eastwards to its junction with Gallows Lane, a distance of approximately 290 metres.

SECOND SCHEDULE 40 mph Speed Limit

FOREST ROW

- (a) London Road A22 - from a point approximately 30 metres west of the boundary of the property known as "Sunnycroft", eastwards for a distance of approximately 370 metres.

NEWHAVEN

- (b) Avis Road B2109 - from a point approximately 37 metres northwest of the western kerbline of Avis Way, to its junction with New Road (A26).
- (c) Lewes Road C7 - from a point approximately 133 metres northwest of the north-western kerbline of Valley Road, north-westwards for a distance of approximately 660 metres.

RINGLES CROSS

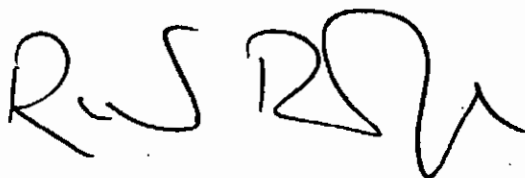
(d) London Road C33

- from a point approximately 950 metres north of its junction with North Row, Uckfield, northwards for a distance of approximately 110 metres.
