EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (B2169 Bayham Road, Bells Yew Green) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2025

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on those lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order.
- 2. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding 50mph on those lengths of road specified in Schedule Two to this Order.
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.
- 4. The following Order is revoked in its entirety: "The East Sussex (B2169 Bayham Road, Bells Yew Green)(50mph Speed Limit) Order 2014".
- 5. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (B2169 Bayham Road, Bells Yew Green) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2025" and shall come into operation on 27 October 2025.

SCHEDULE ONE 40 mph Speed Limit

Bayham Road

From a point 214 metres east of the junction with the C81 Bells Yew Green eastwards to a point 66 metres east of Higham Lane / Ivy Lane crossroads.

SCHEDULE TWO 50 mph Speed Limit

Bayham Road

From a point 66 metres east of the Higham Lane / Ivy Lane crossroads eastwards to a point 166 metres east of the eastern boundary wall of No.1 Forge Cottages.
