**THE EAST SUSSEX (BARRACK ROAD TO HILLSIDE ROAD, BEXHILL)
CYCLE TRACKS ORDER 2025**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT East Sussex County Council made the above Order on 12 September 2025. The effects of the Order are to convert the following footpath into a shared-use cycle track (permitted use for pedal cycles and pedestrians):

1. Footpath Bexhill 103 from its junction with Hillside Road southwards to its junction with Barrack Road.

This Order will not come into force until it is confirmed.
