The East Sussex (Rother District) (Parking Places, Waiting, No Stopping and Loading Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 Amendment No.* Order 202*

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The County Council's reasons for proposing the above-named Order are:

East Sussex County Council is working in partnership with the council's highway contractor, Balfour Beatty Living Places, alongside Rother District Council to amend waiting restrictions in Bexhill.

The proposals are:-

- (i) To introduce an additional length of no waiting at any time restriction at the junction of Richmond Avenue /South Cliff.
- (ii) To extend the existing no waiting at any time restriction at Terminus Avenue at its junction with Colington Avenue.
- (iii) To introduce Goods Vehicle Loading Bay at any time at Colebrooke Road next to Tesco Express.
- (iv) To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions at the junction of Arthur Road/ Piltdown Close/ Downlands Avenue.
- (v) To replace the section of the existing no waiting restriction (Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm) in front of the King Offa Primary Academy, in Down Road, with a no waiting at any time restriction.
- (vi) To introduce no waiting at any time restriction at Hollier's Hill outside the Bexhill Hospital
- (vii) To extend the existing no waiting restriction at any time at Chantry Avenue at its junction with Hollier's Hill.

The proposals are to facilitate the introduction of cycling facilities within Bexhill, and are made:

- To facilitate the safe passage of all road users.
- For preserving and improving the amenities of the area.
- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
