

The Council of the Borough of Bexhill in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. No person shall ride or cause or permit to be ridden any bicycle or tricycle on any of the lengths of footpath specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of April 1968 and may be cited as "The Borough of Bexhill (Various Footpaths) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order, 1968".

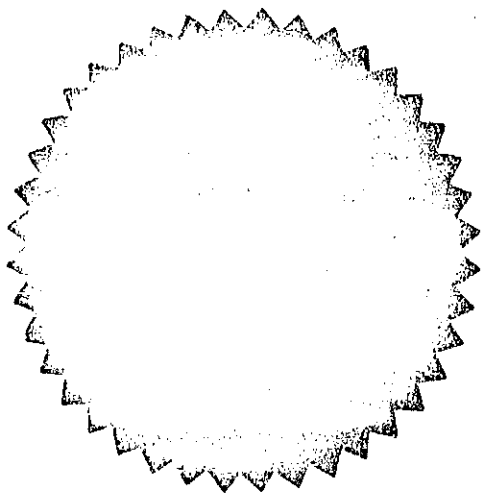
<u>No.</u>	<u>Description of Footpath</u>
48.	—Footpath from Barnhorn Road, east of No. 21 to Meads Road north of No. 20.
49.	—Footpath from Church Hill Avenue, near its junction with Little Common Road to Birk Dale between Nos. 58 and 60.
50.	—Footpath from Firle Road near its junction with Birk Dale to Collington Lane West, west of The White Cottage.
51.	—Footpath from Elsted Road in an easterly direction to Jevington Close.
52.	—Footpath from The Grove to Little Common Road opposite Broad Oak Lane.
53.	Footpath from Turkey Road east of Greenways in a south- —erly direction to the north-west corner of Glenleigh Park Road.
54.	Footpath from The Highlands, 50 yards north of "Heather- —dene" in an easterly direction to Mount Idol View.
55.	Footpath from north of Plemont Gardens in a south-east- —erly direction to Gunters Lane, 83 yards south of Woodsgate Lodge.
56.	Footpath from Windmill Drive, between Nos. 6 and 8 in a —southerly direction to "The Oaks", Gatelands Drive.
57.	Footpath from Chichester Close to Windmill Drive between —Nos. 25 and 27 Windmill Drive.
58.	—Footpath from Gatelands Drive, north of No. 14, in an easterly direction to Old Farm Road.
59.	—Footpath from Victoria Road to Terminue Road between Windsor Road and Reginald Road.
60.	—Footpath north of Suffolk Road, in an easterly direction to North Road.

| 68. | Footpath from the southern end of Christine Close in a southerly direction to Pebsham Lane. |
