ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**The East Sussex (Lewes) (A259, The Drove and Seaford Road, Newhaven)
(40mph Speed Limit) Order 202***

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. The follow Order is hereby revoked in its entirety “The East Sussex (A259 The Drove, Newhaven) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990”.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 mph on that length of road specified in Schedule One to this Order.
3. This Order may be cited as “The East Sussex (Lewes) (A259, The Drove and Seaford Road, Newhaven) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 202* No.*” and shall come into effect on xxxxxx.
4. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose of which it is being used on that occasion.
5. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to any vehicle or vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 if that vehicle or vehicles is/are being used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

Schedule One

40 mph Speed Limit

A259 The Drove/Seaford Road - from a point 104 metres east of the junction of the western approach ramp to the railway bridge with Drove Road to a point on Seaford Road 193.5 metres south-east of the property boundary of Nos. 1 and 1a Mount Close.
