ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**The East Sussex (C718 Mill Road, Hailsham)
(Revocation of Derestriction) Order 2023**

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order and contained in "The East Sussex (C718 Mill Road, Hailsham)(Derestriction) Order 1994" shall cease to be a derestricted road for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act and will become a restricted road by virtue of Section 81 of the Act.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (C718 Mill Road, Hailsham) (Revocation of Derestriction) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 23rd January 2023.

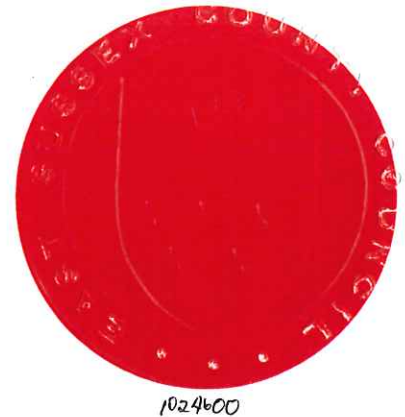

SCHEDULE
