ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (Eastbourne)(Parking Places and Waiting, No Stopping and Loading Restrictions)Traffic Regulation Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make an Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers, which will introduce a Map-Based Traffic Regulation Order (MB-TRO) for parking places, waiting, no stopping and loading restrictions in Eastbourne:-

This TRO removes the need for written descriptions for parking, waiting, no stopping and loading restrictions by providing maps showing the locations of the restrictions throughout Eastbourne. The proposal reflects the current restrictions on street and no physical changes to current restrictions are proposed.

This will portray a more efficient and accurate representation of parking, waiting, no stopping and loading restrictions throughout Eastbourne.
