**The East Sussex County Council (B2106 Terminus Road, Eastbourne)
Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2026 Amendment 1 2026**

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 9, 10(1) and (2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, hereby make the following Order:

1. When this Order comes into effect:

The East Sussex County Council (B2106 Terminus Road, Eastbourne) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2026 and shall have the effect of:-

- (a) Prohibiting traffic 10.00am to 06.00am;
- (b) Prohibiting loading and unloading 10.00am to 06.00am.

- 2. The restrictions will be in place on Terminus Road between Seaside Road and Grand Parade.
- 3. "Specified Officer" is an Officer of the Authority who made the Experimental Order and who has the power to modify or suspend the Order or any provision of the Order, following criteria set out in Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 4. A Specified Officer, or a person authorised on that behalf by a Specified Officer, may, as under the powers in Section 10(2) of the Act, suspend or modify the Order or any provision of the Order.

5. Commencement and Citation

This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex County Council (B2106 Terminus Road, Eastbourne) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2026 Amendment 1 2026 and shall come into force on 31 July 2026.
