East Sussex County Council (Prohibition and restriction of vehicular access, No Loading and Unloading during the times of 09:30AM and 23:00PM) (Eastbourne Borough Consolidation) Order 2025 Amendment Order 541
(Terminus Road - Victoria Place, between Seaside Burlington Road and Grand Parade, Eastbourne)

STATEMENT OF REASONS - RESTRICTED VEHICULAR ACCESS

As part of the Eastbourne Town Centre Movement and Access Package pedestrianisation Scheme in Eastbourne, vehicular access restrictions will be implemented with the use of an experimental traffic regulation order.

Restricted vehicular access will be implemented between the timings of 09:30AM and 23:00PM. This will include no loading/unloading or any other vehicular access, except emergency services during these times.

This will ensure that the pedestrianised area is implemented and the scheme can function as designed once construction is complete. The restrictions in vehicular access will enable the creation of a safer, more attractive town centre environment.

To enable vehicular restriction access on Terminus Road via timings, the following amendments are required to support the scheme on a trial basis for a period of six months:

- Restriction of vehicular access on Terminus Road, between Seaside Road, Burlington Road and Grand Parade between the hours of 09:30AM and 23:00PM. Removeable bollards will be in place to support these arrangements.
- Introduction of road signs to the Terminus Road entrance from Seaside Road.

The Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is proposed for the following reasons:

- 1) To support and enable the scheme to deliver as a pedestrianised area.

The design proposals have been subject to consultation with local residents, stakeholder groups, Eastbourne Borough Council, the local County Council members, and statutory bodies including Sussex Police. Comments received from the statutory consultees have been addressed and, where appropriate, reflected in the final design.
