ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The East Sussex (Restricted Road) (Jarvis Brook) Order 1978

Fast Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under sections 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, hereby make the following Order:

- 1 That length of the Hadlow Down-Crowborough Road, C11, at Jarvis Brook which extends from the south-eastern kerbline of Western Road, C11, south-eastwards for a distance of 142 metres shall be a restricted road for the purposes of section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid.
- The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3 | This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (Restricted Road) (Jarvis Brook) Order 1978" and shall come into operation on 20 March 1978.
