ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (Various Roads: Crowborough and Rotherfield)

(Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on School Keep Clear Markings) Order 2016

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order all references to measured distances are approximate, and

"school entrance markings" means an area of carriageway of a specified road which is comprised within the road markings prescribed in The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"road" means the full width-including footway or verge of any length of highway or of any road to which the public has access;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle or a trailer and have the same meaning as in section 136 of "the Act".

- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait between the hours of 7:30am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday inclusive, except in the month of August, on School Keep Clear entrance markings in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Articles 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the

supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000 (Consequential Modifications to Local Enactments No.1) Order 2002 (S.I.2002/648);
- (d) the vehicle to be used for emergency services purposes.
- 4. This Order may be cited as The East Sussex (Various Roads: Crowborough and Rotherfield) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on School Keep Clear Markings) Order 2016 and shall come into force on 19th February 2016.

Green Lane

Both sides:

From a point 67 metres north of the northern

kerbline of Pellings Farm Close, for a distance

of 87.5 metres in a northerly direction

Hadlow Down Road

Both sides:

From a point 13.5 metres south of the southern

kerbline of Western Road, for a distance of

31.5 metres in a southerly direction.

Western side:

From a point 96 metres south of the south

western kerbline of Western Road, for a

distance of 25.5 metres in a southerly direction

Herne Road

Eastern side:

From a point 68 metres north east of the south

eastern kerbline of Whitehill Road, for a

distance of 25.5 metres in a northerly direction.

Luxford Road

Both sides

From the boundary line between the school

and a property known as Sounion, in a

northerly direction for a distance of 31.5 metres

North Beeches Road

Western side

From a point 29 metres south of the south western kerbline of East Beeches Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of 25.5 metres

Queens Road

South-eastern side:

From a point 22 metres south west of the south

western kerbline of Pollington Place,

in a south-westerly direction for a distance of

25.5 metres

School Lane

Western side:

From a point 114 metres north of the north western kerbline of St Johns Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of 25.5

metres

Eastern side:

From a point 102.5 metres north of the north eastern kerbline of St Johns Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of 25.5

metres

Rotherfield:

North Street

Eastern side:

From a point 5 metres south of the south

eastern kerbline of Hornshurst Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of 37.5

metres

Western side:

From a point opposite a point 3.4 metres south

of the south eastern kerbline of

Hornshurst Road, in a southerly direction for a

distance of 43.5 metres
