

George Street

The following measures would form part of the George Street Improvements.

Measure	Objectives
Introducing a new zebra crossing in the vicinity of Victoria Road.	To make it easier for pedestrians to cross George Street.
Widening of the existing footways.	To improve conditions for pedestrians.
Improvements to bus stop facilities.	To improve conditions for those visiting the town centre by bus and encourage more people to use public transport.
New and upgraded street lighting.	To improve visibility for all those using George Street.
Changes to on-street parking arrangements.	To increase the turnover of vehicles using the spaces.
New and upgraded footway and carriageway surfaces and street furniture.	To improve the environment for all users by enhancing the existing heritage assets in the town.

Proposed changes to parking

On street parking would be reduced by 10 spaces, with parking restricted to a maximum of 30 minutes. A total of 13 parking spaces would still be available along George Street.

These changes would encourage a greater turn over of vehicles and ensure more people could use the spaces provided by preventing vehicles parking in George Street all day.

One new loading bay would be introduced and two new taxi bays provided.

East Sussex County Council is working with Wealden District Council, Hailsham Town Council and Sussex Police to ensure that time limited parking operates successfully.
