

Improvements to a number of key junctions and routes will be required to accommodate the traffic generated from future housing development as it comes forward in areas around North and East Hailsham.

The Movement and Access Strategy for Hailsham and Hellingly (MASHH) identified that some junctions will need major treatment and the County Council has begun putting together plans for:

- A roundabout on the A22 at Hempstead Lane.



A roundabout at the junction of Ersham Road, Diplocks Way, South Road.



The provision of a right turn lane at the Battle Road/London Road junction.

Funding for these schemes will be sought from development contributions associated with the new housing developments.

The introduction of these schemes will be required to accommodate future traffic demand. However, your views will help us refine the proposals. Please let us know if you will be affected by the proposals.




