**The East Sussex (Lewes Town)(Parking Places and Waiting and Loading Restrictions)Traffic Regulation Order 2014  
Amendment No \* 201\***

**Notice** is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to make the above Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will introduce new or revise the existing parking, waiting and loading restrictions along the following lengths of road:-

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, No Waiting At Any Time** in the following roads: Cranedown, Ferrers Road, Grange Road, High Street, Kingston Road, Montacute Road, North Way, Priory Street, Railway Lane, Rotten Row, The Avenue, Windover Crescent and Winterbourne Close

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, Mondays to Fridays, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: Grange Road

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, Mondays to Fridays, 8am-6pm** in the following roads: Ferrers Road and Winterbourne Close

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, Mondays to Saturdays, 8am-6pm** in the following roads: Grange Road and North Way

Changes to **Prohibition of Loading and Unloading, Mondays to Fridays, 8am-10am and 4pm-6pm** in the following roads: High Street

Changes to **Permit Holder Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: Eastport Lane, Priory Street and St Peters Place

Changes to **Permit Holder Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 8am-6pm** in the following road: Grange Road

Changes to **Pay and Display Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 9am-5pm, Maximum stay 2 hours, no return within 1 hour** in the following roads: High Street

Changes to **Permit Holder or Pay and Display Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 8am-6pm** in the following road: Grange Road

Changes to **Permit Holder or Pay and Display Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 9am-5pm** in the following road: Priory Street and The Avenue

Changes to **Permit Holder or Pay and Display Parking Places, Mondays to Saturdays, 9am-5pm, Maximum stay 2 hours, no return within 1 hour** in the following roads: Southover Road

Changes to **Disabled Persons Parking Places** in the following roads: Eastport Lane, High Street, Southover Road, Station Street and St Peters Place

Changes to **Time Limited Parking, Mondays to Fridays 9am-5pm, maximum stay 1 hour, no return within 1 hour** in the following roads: The Gallops

**Changes to Time Limited Parking, Mondays to Saturdays 9am-5pm, maximum stay 20 minutes, no return within 1 hour** in the following roads: Station Street

Changes to **School Keep Clear, Mondays to Fridays (Except August) 8am-4pm** in the following roads: Talbot Terrace

Changes to **Loading Bays for Goods Vehicles, Mondays to Saturdays, 9am-5pm, maximum stay 30 minutes, no return within 1 hour** in the following roads:  
Station Street
