The East Sussex Lewes Town (Parking Places and Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2014 Amendment No.1 Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council have made the above named Order in part, under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, coming into operation on 15 February 2021 which introduces, amends or removes various restrictions along the following lengths of roads:-

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** in the following roads: Baxter Road, Cliffe Industrial Estate, Meridian Road, Middle Way, St Johns Terrace and Talbot Terrace.

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, 8am-6pm Monday to Friday** in the following roads: Clare Road and Cliffe Industrial Estate.

Changes to **Prohibition of Waiting, 9am-5pm Monday to Sunday** in the following road: High Street.

Changes to **Permit Holder or Pay and Display Parking Places, Monday to Friday, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: The Avenue, The Gallops and Warren Drive.

Changes to **Permit Holder or Pay and Display Parking Places, Monday to Saturday, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: Garden Street, Talbot Terrace and The Avenue.

Changes to **Permit Holder Only Parking Places, Monday to Friday, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: The Avenue, The Gallops and Warren Drive.

Changes to **Permit Holder Only Parking Places, Monday to Saturday, 9am-5pm** in the following roads: Bull Lane, St Johns Terrace, St Swithuns Terrace, Talbot Terrace and The Avenue.

Changes to **Pay and Display Parking Places, Monday to Saturday, 9am-5pm, maximum stay 2 hours, no return within 1 hour** in the following road: High Street.

Changes to **Disabled Persons Parking Places At Any Time** in the following roads: Bull Lane, St Swithuns Terrace, Talbot Terrace and High Street.

Removal of **School Keep Clear Markings** in the following roads: Arundel Green and Talbot Terrace.

Introduction of **Motorcycle Parking Places At Any Time** in the following road: Garden Street.

A copy of the made Order, plans showing the lengths of road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing the Order, along with copies of the Orders and Map Tiles being amended can be viewed at consultation.eastsussex.gov.uk/economy-transport-environment/lewes-formal-2018-19. Due to current social distancing requirements, paper copies of documents will not be available to view in our council offices or libraries. People without access to a computer who wish to view details of the scheme should telephone the Parking Team on 01323 466244 to receive the documents by post.

The previously advertised proposals insofar as they relate to the revocation of previous Traffic Regulation Orders have been deferred following consideration of the objections received and decisions made at Planning Committee.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Road Traffic Regulation Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks of the date the Order is made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
