The East Sussex (B2102 High Street, Blackboys)

(40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990

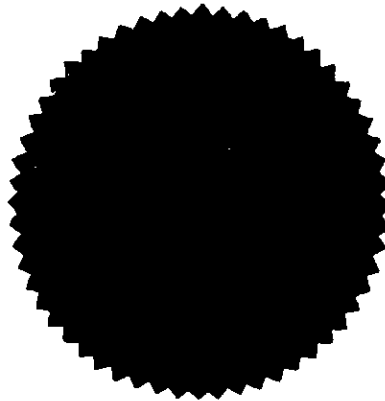
East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on that length of the B2102 High Street, Blackboys which extends from its junction with the B2192 to a point 172 metres west of the western kerbline of School Lane.

2. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (B2102 High Street, Blackboys) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990" and shall come into operation on 22 October 1990.

**The East Sussex (Buxted, Framfield & Blackboys)
(30 mph, 40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2005**

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 84(1) and (2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

In this Order, all measured distances are approximate.

1. The East Sussex (A272 Buxted) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2000; and The East Sussex (Framfield & Blackboys) (30 mph, 40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2005, are hereby revoked.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on those lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on those lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 mph on those lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
5. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (Buxted, Framfield & Blackboys) (30 mph, 40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2005" and shall come into force on 19 August 2005.

**FIRST SCHEDULE
30 mph Speed Limit**

Buxted

1. A272 - From a point approximately 8 metres east of the eastern flank wall of Totease House eastwards to a point approximately 87 metres east of the prolongation of the eastern kerbline of Limes Lane.
2. Limes Lane - (i) From its junction with the A272 southwards for a distance of approximately 37 metres.
- (ii) From its junction with Framfield Road eastwards for a distance of approximately 83 metres.
3. Framfield Road - From a point approximately 20 metres south of its junction with Limes Lane northwards to its junction with the A272.
4. Gordon Road - From its junction with the A272 for its entire length.
5. Higglers Close - From its junction with Gordon Road for its entire length.
6. Broad Oak - From its junction with the A272 for its entire adopted length.
7. Church Road - From its junction with the A272 for its entire adopted length.
8. Park View - From its junction with Church Road for its entire length.
9. Saint Marys Garth - From its junction with Church Road for its entire adopted length.
10. Eight Bells Close - From its junction with the A272 for its entire length.

- 11. Littlewood Lane - From its junction with the A272 for its entire length.
- 12. Britts Farm Road - From its junction with the A272 for its entire length.

Framfield

- 13. B2102 The Street - from the last street light, 45 metres west of the western flank wall of Grange Farm House, eastwards for a distance of 247 metres.

SECOND SCHEDULE

40 mph Speed Limit

Buxted

- 1. A272 - From a point approximately 110 metres northeast of its junction with Spotted Cow Lane, south-westwards to a point approximately 87 metres east of the prolongation of the eastern kerbline of Limes Lane, and from a point approximately 8 metres east of the eastern flank wall of Totease House, westwards to a point approximately 610 metres west of its junction with Framfield Road.

Blackboys

- 1. B2102 High Street - from its junction with the B2192 Lewes Road, eastwards to a point 54 metres west of the prolongation of the western kerbline of the John Dann Close.
- 2. John Dann Close - from its junction with the B2102 Framfield Road, southwards for its entire length.

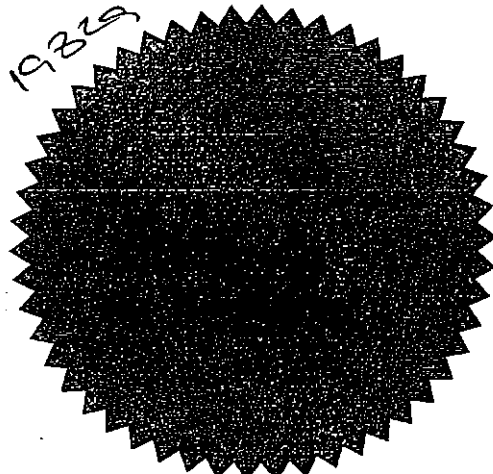
THIRD SCHEDULE

50 mph Speed Limit

Framfield

- 1. B2102 The Street - from a point 202 metres east of the western flank wall of Grange Farm House, eastwards to a point 54 metres west of the prolongation of the western kerbline of John Dann Close.
- 2. B2192 Lewes Road - from a point 206 metres northeast of its junction with the B2102 High Street, south-westwards, then southwards to a point 165 metres south of its junction with Stonebridge Lane.
- 3. C508 Star Lane - from its junction with the B2102 High Street, south-westwards to its junction with the B2192 Lewes Road.
