This would involve the introduction of raised kerbs to assist with access to/from the buses and clearways to prevent private cars parking within the bus lay-bys. Cycle/Pedestrian Network

We are planning to introduce a cycle route along the A259 Brighton Road, with the introduction a shared cycle and pedestrian path on the existing footway on the northern side of the A259 around Rushy Hill and into Newhaven Town Centre where it would join onto the existing cycle network at North Lane. Shared pedestrian/cycle facilities would also be provided to tie into the existing cycle network in the Denton area.
