



## Advantages:

- All HGVs over 10m in length will be banned from travelling through the centre of the village with the exception of those requiring access.
- Congestion caused by many large HGVs will be reduced as "through" vehicles will be banned.
- The "Keep Clear" markings will reduce congestion and improve traffic flow.
- Damage to the Kings Arms should be minimised.
- The following will be unaffected by the ban:
  - \* The waste tanker trips from the old landfill site near Dewlands Hill
  - \* Public transport
  - \* Local agricultural vehicles
  - \* Delivery vehicles

## Disadvantages:

• The proposals will not eliminate all long HGVs from travelling through the village. Deliveries will still need to be accommodated.
