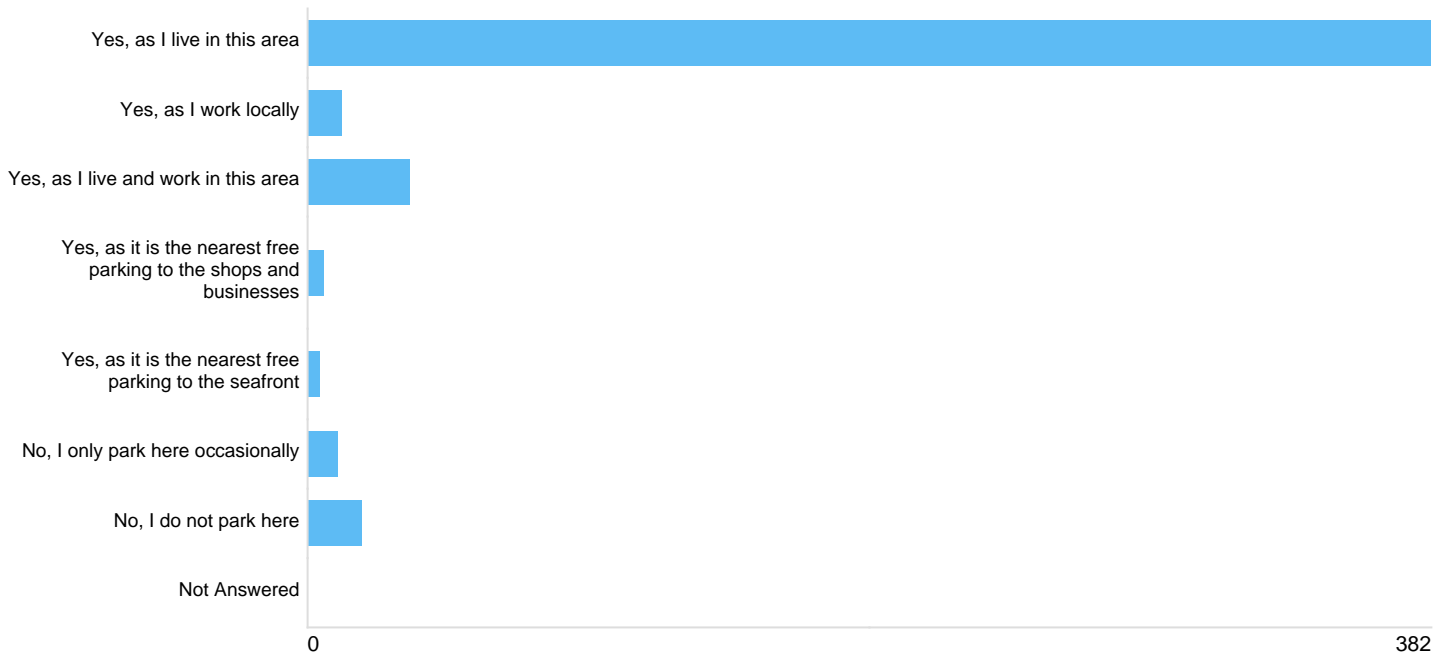

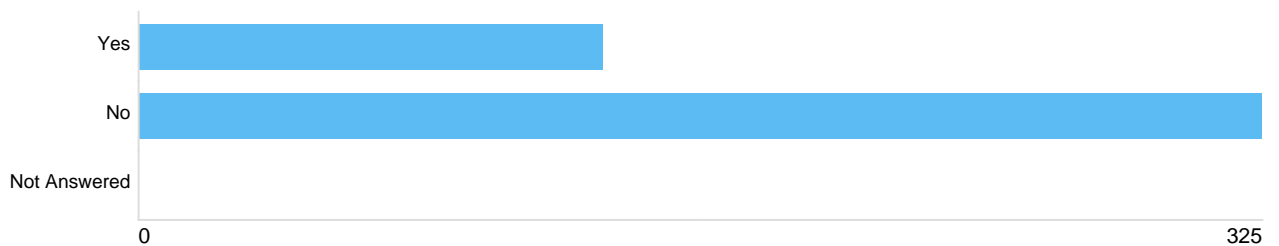

Question 5: Do you think controlled parking bays should be introduced to this area?

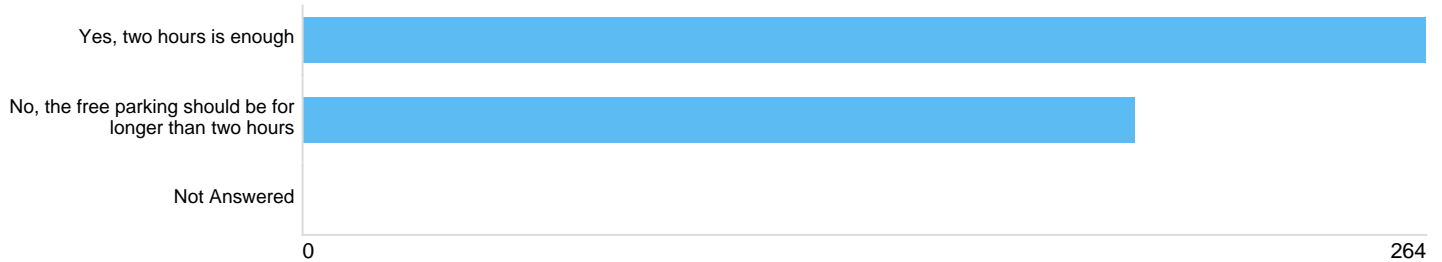
