The East Sussex (Eastbourne)(Parking Places and Waiting, No Stopping and Loading Restrictions)Traffic Regulation Order 2021 Amendment No.\* 202\* (Sandpiper Walk)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The County Council's reasons for proposing the above named Order are;

As part of the residential development of the land north of Sandpiper Walk & Kingfisher Drive, Eastbourne; highway works including a new access, a flat top road hump and no waiting at any time restrictions are being proposed to increase highway and pedestrian safety.

The proposal includes the introduction of double yellow line restrictions on both sides of Sandpiper Walk from the junction of Kingfisher Drive eastwards for a distance of 93m to the northern side and 88m on the southern side.

Reasons:

1. To improve pedestrian safety by allowing unrestricted visibility on Sandpiper Walk
2. To facilitate the passage of vehicles along Sandpiper Walk and to allow unobstructed access to off street parking.
