**The East Sussex (Sandpiper Walk, Eastbourne)  
(Traffic Calming)**

**Notice** is hereby given that East Sussex County Council propose to construct under the powers contained in Section 90A-F of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, a flat topped raised table, the purpose of which is to reduce the speed of traffic entering the road and contribute to road safety as described below: -

**Raised Table**

75mm high flat top, 5 metres width, 7 metres long (including approach ramps)

**Sandpiper Walk** – at the south eastern kerb line with Kingfisher Drive, south-eastwards for a distance of 7 metres.
