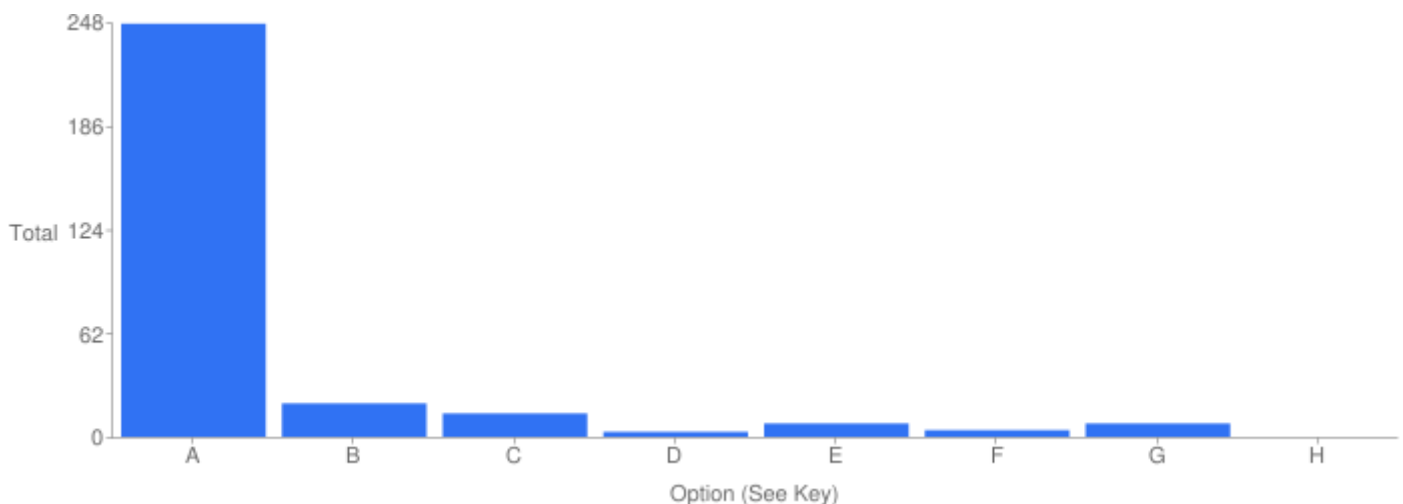

Question 4: Do you normally park in this area? Please tick one box.

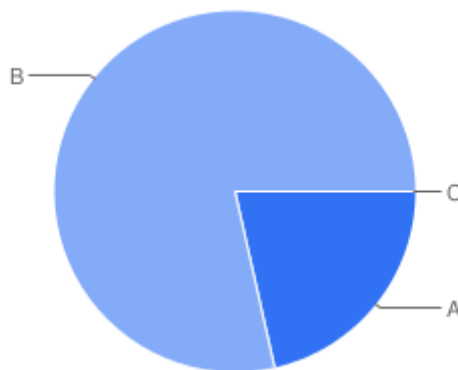

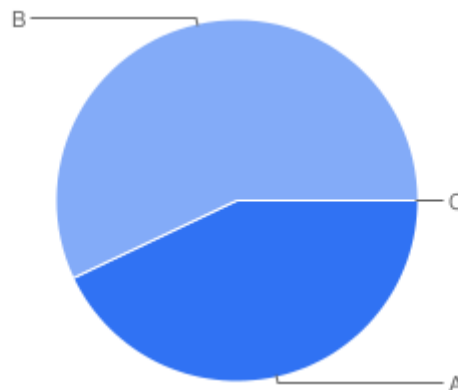

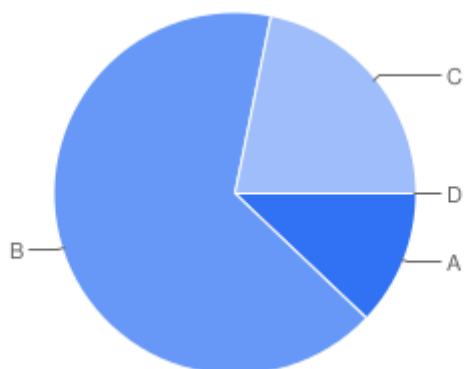
Table of "Length of time for free parking"

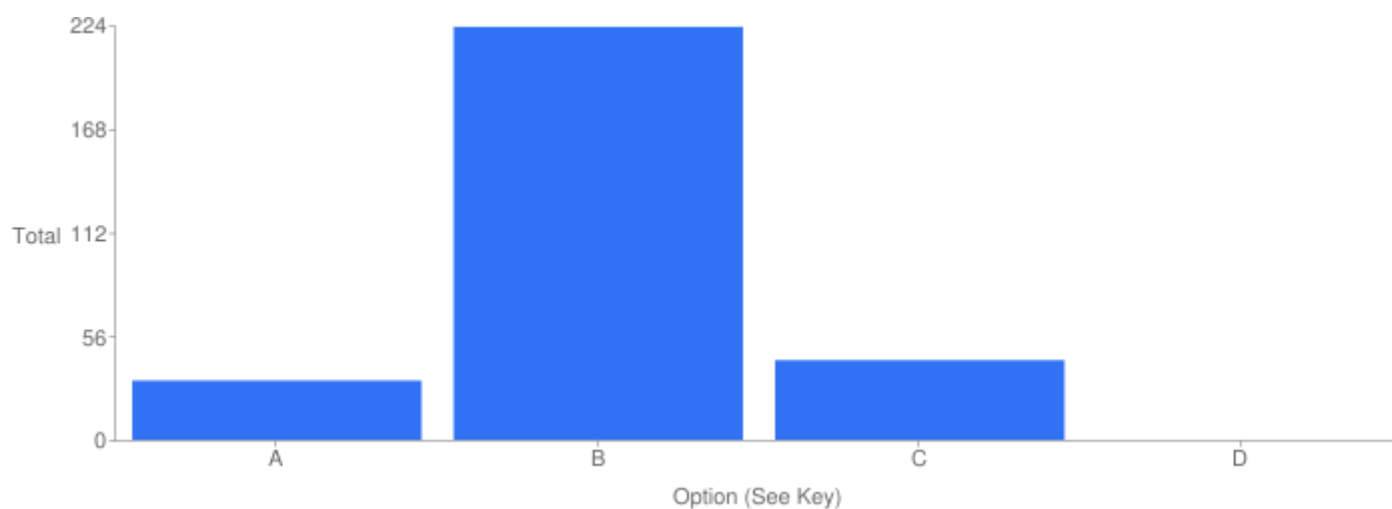
Table of "Permission for sign to be fixed to wall"
