The Council ask people for their views before important changes are made.

When the Council ask people for their views it is called a **consultation**.



We want to make sure that we listen to people and know what they need.

So we use your views to help shape and design our services.



You may want to ask for support to take part in the consultation.

- A friend or someone in your family
- Your social worker or care manager.



The consultation will close on 10 March 2023

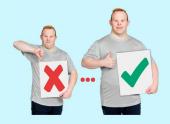
This means that you need to send us your thoughts and views by this date if you want to take part.

Introduction



One You East Sussex is a health and wellbeing service for people living in East Sussex.

We support people with their health, including eating well and being more active.



We are thinking about changing how the service supports people.



The aim would be to use the money that we have to help as many people as possible to improve their health.

How does One You East Sussex work at the moment?



Everyone living in East Sussex who is 16 or over can use the service.

People can choose to be supported online, over the phone or face-to-face.



Everybody can have a health assessment which checks how we can support them.

Why do we want to make changes?



We checked whether our services are working well and found that One You could be better.



We get money from the government to make sure that our residents have the chance to be as healthy as possible.



We think we can use the money in a better way that will support people to be more healthy.



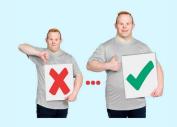
We can support people to be more healthy by helping them to change their behaviour.



Some people are more likely to be less healthy than others.

Such as people who live in poor areas and people who have a disability.

We want to work hard to support these people.



If we aim to help the people who are the most likely to have poor health we can make the biggest improvements to people's health.



We think that making changes to the service will allow us to save money.

This money can be used to keep making the service better.

What changes do we want to make?



Everyone who wants to use the service will still get a health assessment and be able to use online resources that will support them to make changes to their health.



People who are the most likely to have poor health will get higher levels of support.

This might include face-to-face support from a health coach or being part of a support group.

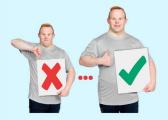


We would always try to offer people the sort of service that they think would suit them the best.

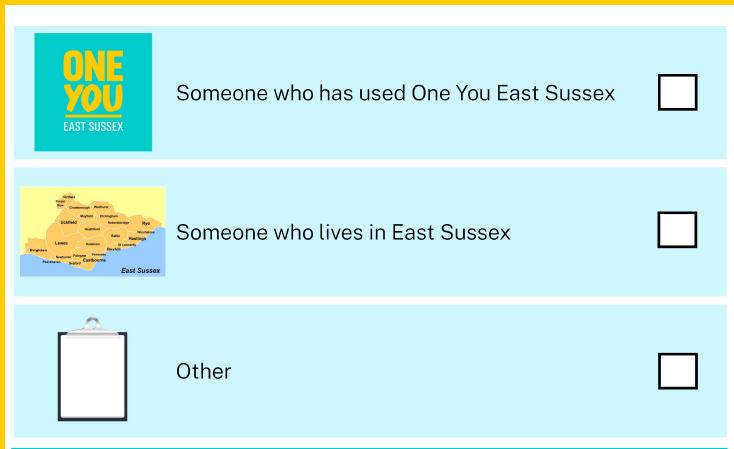

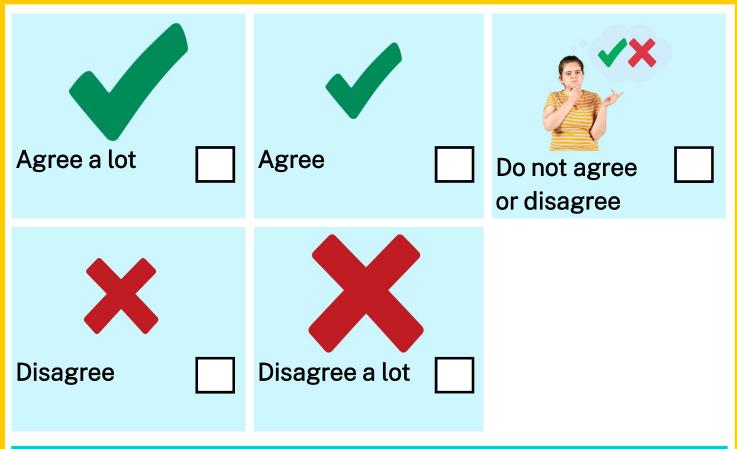
